My Testimony of Becoming a Watchman

There was a time in my life when I didn't fully understand what it meant to be a watchman. I knew how to pray, intercede, and seek God for my family, but I didn't yet realize the authority He had placed on me to see, hear, and act prophetically on behalf of others, my region, and even the land itself.

It began when God started to open my eyes in the spirit. I would notice things others overlooked, patterns, behaviors, even spiritual atmospheres that didn't sit right. At first, I thought I was overreacting. But the Lord began to teach me that what I was sensing wasn't my imagination; it was intercession calling me to attention. I was seeing what the Holy Spirit was revealing.

Just like Ezekiel, I heard Him say in my spirit,

"Son of man, I have made you a watchman... so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me" (Ezekiel 3:17).

That moment marked a shift. I stopped brushing things off. Instead, I brought them into prayer. I learned to discern not only what was happening, but *why* it was happening, and how to go into the Courts of Heaven to seek God's justice and mercy.

The Holy Spirit began teaching me through dreams, visions, scriptures, and even promptings I couldn't explain. I would be awakened in the night to pray. Sometimes I'd weep without knowing why until God showed me a person, place, or situation He was inviting me to cover. The prompting was holy. It was a call to *stand on the wall*.

I began to understand that a watchman doesn't just sound the alarm; they also war in the Spirit. Like Nehemiah, who rebuilt the wall with a sword in one hand and a tool in the other (Nehemiah 4:17), I was learning to build and protect what God had entrusted to me.

I began to pray differently. I stopped praying from a place of panic and began praying from my seat in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6). I would ask the Lord, "What is the legal right the enemy is using here?" And then I would step into the Courts of Heaven with repentance, scripture, and faith.

Sometimes I stood in the gap for my family, sometimes for people I didn't even know personally. Other times, it was about a territory, land, water, or government. And always, God was faithful to respond.

There were moments I felt unqualified. But God reminded me that He does not call the qualified; He qualifies the called. His Word says, **"The Sovereign Lord has given me a well-instructed tongue... He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being instructed"** (Isaiah 50:4).

Becoming a watchman didn't happen overnight. It has been layer by layer, revelation by revelation. But one thing is certain: my "yes" has unlocked something not only in me, but in those I've stood in the gap for. This is a holy assignment. It requires sensitivity, obedience, repentance, and courage. But more than anything, it requires intimacy with the Lord.

I believe God is calling many to step into their role as watchmen in this hour. If He is stirring something in your spirit, don't ignore it. Say yes. He will train your hands for war and your fingers for battle (Psalm 144:1), and He will surround you with heavenly help as you obey His voice.

"I will stand my watch and set myself on the rampart, and watch to see what He will say to me..."
(Habakkuk 2:1)

That is what I do now. And I've never been the same.

Becoming a Watchman for God

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What Is a Watchman?

A watchman is like a guard on a wall. In Bible times, watchmen stood on city walls to watch for danger and alert the people. Today, God still calls people to be watchmen, but now we watch with our **spiritual eyes and ears**.

What Do Watchmen Do?

1. **See** – God shows them things in dreams, visions, or their spirit.
 2. **Warn** – They tell others what God is showing so people can repent or pray.
 3. **Pray** – They intercede in prayer for people, cities, nations, and creation.
 4. **Prophecy** – They speak God's truth to bring light to darkness.
 5. **Go into the Courts of Heaven** – They stand before God, asking for justice and closing legal rights the enemy is using.
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How Do You Know You're Called to Be a Watchman?

Look for these signs:

- You notice things others don't, spiritually or even in nature.
 - You have dreams or visions that seem important or symbolic.
 - You often feel the urge to pray for people or places, even strangers.
 - You feel things deeply, whether it's sadness, urgency, or even a warning, when something is wrong.
 - God often wakes you up in the night to pray (especially between 3am–6am, the "Fourth Watch").
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How Do You Move in Authority as a Watchman?

1. **Know who you are in Christ.** (Luke 10:19 — “I have given you authority...”)
 2. **Use the Word of God as your weapon.** (Ephesians 6:17 — “...the sword of the Spirit...”)
 3. **Ask the Holy Spirit to show you what to do.** He is your Teacher.
 4. **Be obedient** to share or pray when God shows you something.
 5. **Enter the Courts of Heaven** when needed: repent, present the case, and ask God to shut the enemy’s access.

Real-Life Examples of a Watchman's Call

1. Being a Watchman for Your Family

Example: You suddenly feel a strong urge to pray for your son or daughter, even though everything appears fine on the outside. Later, you find out he or she was struggling with thoughts of discouragement or fear that day.

What a Watchman Does:

- Intercedes immediately when prompted by the Holy Spirit
- Declares scriptures like *Isaiah 54:13* ("All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children.")
- May take the issue into the **Courts of Heaven** to remove any generational legal rights the enemy could be using (like rejection, fear, or word curses).

2. Being a Watchman for Strangers

Example: While at the grocery store, you sense a stirring in your spirit when you pass by a man or woman. Nothing appears unusual outwardly, but the Holy Spirit prompts you to pray. You may never know their name or story, but your obedience in that moment releases Heaven's help into their situation, whether it's grief, danger, or a hidden need. A watchman doesn't always see the results, but sows seeds of intercession in faith.

What a Watchman Does:

- Quietly prays in the Spirit, asking God to send his or her comfort
- Might speak an encouraging word led by the Holy Spirit
- Stands in the gap for healing, even if the person never knows

Hebrews 13:2 reminds us that we may be entertaining angels unaware. Watchmen are sensitive to what's hidden beneath the surface.

3. Being a Watchman for the Government and Leaders

Example: You read something in the news and your spirit is stirred, not with fear, but with urgency to pray for truth to come out in government.

What a Watchman Does:

- Prays for righteous leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-2)

- Declares scriptures like *Psalm 33:12* – “Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord...”
- Enters the **Courts of Heaven** to repent for national sins, ask for justice, and remove any evil legal rights over regions or leaders

Esther was a watchwoman; she fasted and interceded for her nation at just the right time.

4. Being a Watchman Over the Land and Water

Example: You feel burdened every time you pass a particular piece of land, maybe it's been misused or cursed (e.g., abortion clinics, Freemason lodges, historic bloodshed). You ask God why.

What a Watchman Does:

- Asks God to reveal what happened there
- Repents for the sins on the land (*Leviticus 18:24–28*)
- Dedicates it back to God using communion, oil, and decrees (*Isaiah 61:4, Romans 8:19–22*)
- Breaks evil altars and releases God's angels to protect it

Rivers, lakes, mountains, and soil all “groan” under sin (*Romans 8*). Watchmen release healing and blessing back into creation.

Communion as a Watchman

Why It Matters

Before entering the Courts of Heaven or standing in the gap, taking communion is a holy, covenant act. It is a legal transaction in the spirit realm that testifies of the finished work of Jesus Christ. His body and blood are your access, your covering, and your authority.

Communion is not just a symbol, it is a declaration that you are in covenant with God through Christ. You are reminding the enemy, Heaven, and your own soul that:

- You are forgiven (Matthew 26:28)
 - You are healed (Isaiah 53:5)
 - You are in covenant (Luke 22:19–20)
 - You are made righteous (2 Corinthians 5:21)
 - The blood of Jesus speaks on your behalf (Hebrews 12:24)
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Prayer Before Taking Communion

Examine Your Heart (1 Corinthians 11:28):

“Father, I come before You humbly and with reverence. Search me and know me. If there is any sin in me, known or unknown, I repent. (Take time here to list and confess any known sins.)

Through my authority in Christ Jesus, I renounce every agreement with darkness, and I forgive anyone who has hurt or wronged me. I ask that You wash me clean by the blood of Jesus (1 John 1:9) and prepare my heart to partake of this holy covenant meal.”

Prayer Over the Bread

“Lord Jesus, I hold this bread in holy reverence, remembering Your body that was broken, beaten, and bruised for me. As it is written: *‘This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me’* (1 Corinthians 11:24).

You were wounded for my transgressions, crushed for my iniquities; the chastisement for my peace was upon You, and by Your stripes I am healed (Isaiah 53:5).

I honor Your suffering, the lashes, the nails, the torn flesh, and I receive the full benefit of Your sacrifice. I declare that every area of my life—body, soul, and spirit—is coming into divine alignment with the healing and wholeness You purchased at Calvary.

Let every affliction, infirmity, trauma, and soul wound now bow to the authority of Your finished work. As I partake of this bread, I receive healing, restoration, and covenant strength. I eat by faith, in oneness with You, remembering that *“whoever eats of this bread will live forever”* (John 6:51).

I decree that as Your body was broken, mine is made whole. I take this bread as a prophetic act of agreement, my life is hidden in You. Let this act of communion silence every accusation and speak a better word over me and those I intercede for (Hebrews 12:24).

In Jesus’ holy name, Amen.”

Eat the bread.

Prayer Over the Cup

“Lord Jesus, I lift this cup with awe and gratitude, remembering Your words: *‘This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you’* (Luke 22:20).

I thank You for Your blood, holy, sinless, and eternal, poured out for the forgiveness of my sins (Matthew 26:28). Your blood speaks a better word than the blood of Abel (Hebrews 12:24); it speaks redemption, not condemnation... healing, not shame... covenant, not separation.

‘Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness’ (Hebrews 9:22), and by Your blood, I have been made righteous (Romans 5:9), cleansed from every defilement of the flesh and spirit (Hebrews 9:14), and drawn near to the Father (Ephesians 2:13).

I apply Your blood over myself, body, soul, and spirit. I apply it over my family, over the gates of our homes, over our minds, our relationships, and every assignment You have given me. I place the blood of Jesus between us and every demonic assault, backlash, accusation, retaliation, and delay. *For we overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony* (Revelation 12:11).

As I drink this cup, I receive fresh anointing, divine protection, and holy boldness to stand in my watchman assignment. Let the blood silence every accusation in the Courts of Heaven. Let it sever every ungodly soul tie, and speak mercy over every generational iniquity. Let it mark me and those I cover as set apart, protected, and fully Yours.

Lord, seal me again in covenant love. Empower me to walk in holiness, in truth, and in fire. May this holy exchange restore what was stolen, renew what was weary, and release heavenly justice and alignment over all I stand in the gap for.

I drink this cup in faith, declaring Your Kingdom come, Your will be done. In Jesus’ mighty name, Amen.”

Drink from the cup.

Final Declaration

"I boldly declare that I am in eternal covenant with the Lord God Almighty through the body and blood of my Savior, Jesus Christ. I have been bought with a price (1 Corinthians 6:20), redeemed from the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13), and sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise (Ephesians 1:13).

I stand clothed in the righteousness of Christ (Isaiah 61:10), washed clean by His blood (Revelation 1:5), and hidden in Him (Colossians 3:3). The accuser has no legal claim to my life, my purpose, or my family, for the blood of Jesus has blotted out every handwriting of ordinance that was against us (Colossians 2:14).

I have legal standing in the Courts of Heaven as a redeemed child of the Most High God, a co-heir with Christ (Romans 8:17), and an ambassador of His Kingdom (2 Corinthians 5:20). I am commissioned to watch, to warn, and to intercede (Ezekiel 3:17). I declare that I have been given authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means harm me (Luke 10:19).

No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue that rises in judgment, I condemn (Isaiah 54:17), for this is my heritage as a servant of the Lord and my righteousness is of Him. The blood of Jesus speaks a better word over me and my bloodline, speaking redemption, restoration, justice, and peace (Hebrews 12:24).

I declare I am covered, commissioned, and consecrated for this hour. I walk in boldness, humility, and obedience, carrying out my assignment as a faithful watchman on the wall. The Lord is my Keeper (Psalm 121:5), and His truth is my shield and buckler (Psalm 91:4).

I step forward in alignment with Heaven's will, decreeing: Let the Kingdom of God be established in and through me, in Jesus' mighty name. Amen."

Prayer to Accept the Watchman Call

Father God,

I come before You in reverence and surrender, recognizing that You are the Sovereign Lord who sees all, knows all, and calls forth Your servants for such a time as this (Esther 4:14). I thank You for opening my spiritual eyes to see and my ears to hear what the Spirit of the Lord is saying (Revelation 2:7).

I humbly accept the call to be a watchman on the wall (Isaiah 62:6). I acknowledge that this is not a light assignment but a holy commissioning. I repent for every time I ignored Your nudge, silenced my discernment, or feared the cost of obedience. I now say “yes” to Your call and step into the position You have ordained for me in Your divine order.

Teach me to watch and pray as Jesus instructed (Matthew 26:41), not only for myself but for my family, my city, my region, and the nations. Make me alert in the spirit, that I may not be caught unaware but instead stand ready, awake, and armored with Your truth (Ephesians 6:13–18).

Anoint me to discern the times and seasons (1 Chronicles 12:32). Sharpen my hearing that I may be sensitive to the movements of Heaven and the whispers of the Holy Spirit (John 16:13). Train my hands for war and my fingers for battle (Psalm 144:1), so that my intercession tears down strongholds and releases Heaven’s will on the earth.

Father, I ask You to baptize me afresh in the fire of Your holiness. Let Your Word be a fire shut up in my bones (Jeremiah 20:9). May I speak not from flesh or fear, but from the Spirit of Truth (John 14:26). Let my declarations carry the authority of Heaven and align with what is written in the books of destiny for those You have called me to cover (Psalm 139:16; Daniel 7:10).

When You reveal injustice, give me boldness to bring it before Your Courts, not with accusation but with hope. Empower me to intercede in Your courtroom with confidence in the blood of Jesus, knowing that the accuser has already been overcome (Revelation 12:10–11).

I ask that angels be assigned to me according to Your will, ministering, warring, and scribe angels, so that nothing You speak is lost or delayed (Hebrews 1:14; Psalm 103:20). Help me to pray according to Your heart, to speak only what You say, and to love as You love.

Father, I declare that I am not my own, I am Yours (1 Corinthians 6:19–20). I surrender my will, my voice, my time, and my insight to Your purposes. I receive the mantle of the watchman with fear of the Lord, but also with joy, for I know that You are faithful to equip those You call (1 Thessalonians 5:24).

Thank You for entrusting me with heavenly assignments. I step into my post now, not as one who watches in vain, but as one anchored in covenant with the God who never slumbers nor sleeps (Psalm 121:3–4). Let Your glory be my rear guard and Your truth my compass.

In the name of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Righteous Judge, I accept the call. Amen.

- All generational sins and iniquities that still speak in our bloodlines (Nehemiah 1:6; Daniel 9:4–6)

Through my authority in Christ Jesus, I renounce every agreement made with darkness by us or our ancestors, and I break every soul tie, blood covenant, or ungodly alliance. I ask that the blood of Jesus now cleanse every legal record, altar, curse, and accusation the enemy is using to afflict us (Colossians 2:14–15; Hebrews 12:24).

I forgive those who have wounded, betrayed, or oppressed us. I release them into Your hands, and I ask You to heal every soul wound, especially where trauma or loss has left an open gate (Matthew 6:14–15; Luke 23:34).

Lord, as a watchman, I stand on behalf of these individuals, this territory, and this assignment. I lay every burden at Your feet. I ask that Your holy fire consume anything in us that is not aligned with Your truth. Remove every veil, stronghold, or deception. Let Your truth prevail in our minds, emotions, and decisions.

Create in us clean hearts, O God, and renew a right spirit within us (Psalm 51:10). Let the Spirit of Truth lead us into all truth (John 16:13), and restore us fully to our covenant identity in Christ.

I receive the cleansing of the blood of Jesus over our lives, our households, our region, and every area where we have been assigned to watch and pray. Let the blood of the Lamb now speak on our behalf and silence the accuser (Revelation 12:11). Let every accusation be disarmed and overruled by Your mercy.

Thank You, Father, for Your patience, Your justice, and Your love. I ask now for Your righteous verdict and divine restoration, in Jesus' mighty name. **Amen.**

Step 1: Approach the Courtroom

Father God, I come before Your Court today by the blood of Jesus Christ. I ask that You move this case from the Courtroom of Judgment to the Throne Room of Grace and Mercy.

I ask that the blood of Jesus now cleanse every legal record, altar, curse, and accusation the enemy is using to afflict us (Colossians 2:14–15; Hebrews 12:24).

I forgive every leader, judge, policy maker, or influencer who has made decisions contrary to God's Word. I release them into Your hands, and I ask You to heal every soul wound in our city and government system, especially where trauma, oppression, and injustice have opened gates.

Lord, as a watchman, I stand on behalf of this city and its leaders. I ask that Your holy fire consume anything in our governing systems that is not aligned with Your righteousness.

Remove every veil, stronghold, or deception. Let truth prevail in policies, decisions, and leadership.

Create in us clean hearts, O God, and renew a right spirit within our city. Let the Spirit of Truth lead us into all truth, and restore our city to its ordained destiny.

I receive the cleansing of the blood of Jesus over my city _____, over its gates and governmental structures. Let the blood of the Lamb now speak on our behalf and silence the accuser (Revelation 12:11).
